The day starts at 9 am, so the kids come into the pre school. When everybody is here, it's time for the circle time.

In the morning circle, the children are greeted individually. The children greet themselves with individual interactions. For example, the name of the child is sung and clapped.

It looks like this: Good morning dear Sandra, we clap for you. The children then perform this action. In addition, children's songs are sung. The content is about different animals and their sounds, but the children were also allowed to choose the songs. Furthermore, one is taught the alphabet and numbers. And it is asked about the weather. After the morning circle, the children have about an hour of free play which should promote the free development of the child. Then they clean up and prepare the children for lunch. Around 10:30/11:00 am there is lunchtime. Before going to the garden at 12:00, the diapers are changed while the others play. After the garden, hands are washed and jackets are taken off. At 1:20 pm -1:40 pm the toddlers are picked up by the parents. At 2:00 pm the elementary students arrive. They eat their lunch and then do their homework. If the weather is good, sometimes they go to the playground. 




Shoppingcenter:

Trinity college:


We went to trinity college ourselves and wanted to go to the library, but unfortunately it didn't work out because you had to pay for the tickets online by credit card, however we went to the campus.

The paintings were very expressive. The colors were also intense.
















Hiking with the host family:

We all watched movies together in the evenings and we started a series with Evan called "entucourage".












Favorite excursion
